

Health & Safety Statement

The Group's commitment to health and safety

eQuality Solutions Group Ltd and all its subsidiaries regards the management of health and safety as an integral part of its business and as a management priority. Group culture

Workforce's responsibility

Management, employees, and operatives have responsibility for implementing the specific arrangements made under this policy throughout the Group. All employees are expected to read the relevant sections of the employee handbook, familiarise themselves with its provisions and carry out their defined responsibilities.

A copy of the employee handbook and relevant Health and Safety documents will be held by the People and Culture Team and be made available to all employees.

Employees are expected and encouraged to be proactive on health and safety issues as part of the continued development of the health and safety culture of the Group.

All employees, contractors and sub-contractors are required to cooperate with the Group and their colleagues in implementing the policy and shall ensure that their own work is without risks to themselves and others as far as reasonably practicable.

Training and advice

The Group will provide appropriate training and make available competent health and safety advice and adequate resources, including time and money so that legal obligations may be met.
